

Thoughts from Hobo-E... the lead beggar

Why do I do this thing we call Beggarman Ministries?

Three reasons:

I need it.

Others need it — and it only takes one.

As best I can tell, it's what I was created to do.



1 — I need it.

I need community and to remember what's true when the emotional waves of being human hit. I need support to keep making good choices, wisdom from others, encouragement when I'm sad, prayer when I'm nervous, and a helping hand when I'm weary. I need a warm bed, and people to confess to when I'm hurting or lost.

None of us walk alone. I wouldn't be here without the people God used to help me when I was broken and barely surviving. Others hoped for me when I couldn't hope, loved me when I couldn't love myself, and spoke light when I only heard despair. And I still need community — we all do.

2 — Others need it, and it only takes one.

Many people are stuck in sorrow, addiction, incarceration, financial impossibilities, or the long shadows of bad choices. They need a safe place to be honest, held accountable, to learn new rhythms, find work, or simply believe a new life is possible. And often, it only takes one open door. One innkeeper. One boy with loaves and fish. One woman named Rahab. One conversation between Jesus and a blind beggar. Over and over, a single act of compassion changes a life forever. If I am to live out my faith, I want to be that one — and to empower a whole community to join me in bearing one another's burdens, speaking hope and restoration into hurting lives.

3 — As best I can tell, this is what I'm created to do.

In 1997, on a retreat with Brennan Manning, he gave us a quote that has stayed with me: "The place God calls you is where your greatest passion and the world's greatest need intersect." I see that intersection clearly in Beggarman Ministries.

My passion is creating safe places and connections of love — for residents, volunteers, staff, and all who partner with us. One of my greatest joys is watching a wounded friend receive the gift of hope & value. In a world full of need, this seems to be exactly where God has placed me.

Thank you — truly — to each of you who partner with us. I may be the "lead beggar," but I cannot do this alone. Your gifts keep this ministry touching and transforming lives.

What do I want?

To leave a legacy of offering value to those who've been told they're too far gone. To break the "rules" of what is supposed to be and open doors of hope. To be known for saying "yes" when others say "not now." To err on the side of compassion and build a community where people feel safe, listened to, and never alone.

So I use my gifts to help create a place of radical love, authentic friendship, deep value, laughter, faith, music, and sometimes ridiculous fun.



2026 Beggarman Ministries Vision & Goals

1 – Build a Sustainable & Scalable Organizational Structure

To grow well and steward our time, resources, and opportunities with excellence, we plan to expand the team with roles that complement Eric's gifts and support long-term impact:

Increase administrative support for Beggarman's infrastructure

Expand grant-writing capacity

Hire a Development Coordinator (events, online presence, community engagement)

2 – Complete Key Property Renovations & Projects

Finish and open Auntie's House (ask us for remaining project needs!)

Build Auntie's Shed and Garage

Renovate Grandma's House garage into a meeting space and workout area

3 – Pursue New Beggarman Houses

Begin exploring a possible women's home and/or a third men's home

Open a "next step" graduate house for men who want continued community but cannot yet secure a lease

4 – Strengthen Local Church Partnerships

Build ongoing relationships with at least five additional churches this year

5 – Establish a Sustainable Annual Rhythm of Events

Spring Birthday Celebration – May 13

Fireworks Tent – June 27-July 5

Men's Campout Retreat – mid-September

Fall Fun Run & Car Smash – mid-October (following GAD Parade)

Thanksgiving Ridiculous Inflatable Run 4 Fun

Annual Donor Appreciation Dinner

Other ongoing events: Wichita's Got Talent, Applebee's Music Nights, R4R, and more

6 – Improve Donor Management & Communication

Develop a consistent system for communication, gratitude, and ongoing relationship-building

7 – Beyond 2026: Explore Income-Generating Options.

To support Beggarman's sustainability and provide employment for residents, we will begin exploring a few possibilities (not definite, but options): Car detailing, Lawn care business, Local thrift shop, etc.

Bottom line: We deeply believe in this model of transitional sober living, and we are prayerfully discerning how to expand in healthy, sustainable ways so more people can find safe places to heal and rebuild their lives. 




